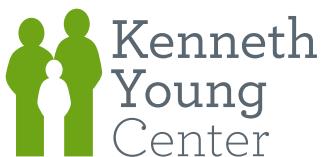

KYC provides compassionate, community-based mental health and older adult services. For the last forty-six years, we've met the evolving needs of clients from 3 to 105 years old. As a 501(c)3 charitable organization, donations to support our efforts are tax deductible.



**6,574** adolescents in 30 schools participated in our Positive Youth Development Program

**6,553** hours of mentoring support were given to children and adolescents

**5,636** hospital and community based prescreens were completed

**2,837** in-home needs assessments were completed for homebound elderly clients

**1,669** Screening and Assessment Support Services (SASS) crisis interventions were provided to children in severe distress or suicidal situations

**2,818** visits were made to the Drop-In Center in Mount Prospect, providing adults with mental health support needs a safe place to learn and engage with others
